



2019 Grant Application Procedures

Eligibility

The Curry County Cultural Coalition supports projects and programs in the fields of arts, humanities, and heritage throughout the county. Grants up to \$1,000 may be awarded to eligible organizations.

Is your organization involved in producing or promoting **art**: *painting, sculpture, ceramics, textile art, music, drama, or writing*? Is your organization involved in **heritage**: *history and culture* of a community? **Humanities** include all of the above plus studies such as philosophy or history. *Libraries* are included in this category. *Events* qualify.

Applications for grants for 2019 will be accepted between September 20 and November 10, 2018.

Grant recipients must complete their projects and submit the 2019 Grant Report to the Curry County Cultural Coalition by September 30, 2019.

Process

1. Download the Grant Application. Fill out the PDF form completely, including the financial data. Incomplete forms will not be considered. Save a copy of the completed PDF file.
2. Proposed projects must meet at least one of the Priorities of the Cultural Coalition as listed in the Project Section of the form.
3. Email your application to grants@curryccc.org no later than November 10, 2018. You will receive an email acknowledging that your application was received.
4. Applications will be reviewed within 30 days following the announced deadline.
5. A Grant Report is due within 30 days after the project is completed. ALL Grant Reports are due no later than September 30, 2019.
6. First-time requests will be considered first.
7. Money requested must be for a project that has not yet started. No retroactive grants will be awarded.
8. Any recipients of previous grants from CCCC must have submitted Grant Reports for those projects before being eligible for a new grant.
9. You must give credit to the Oregon Cultural Trust and Curry County Cultural Coalition on all publicity for your project/event.
